

PARENTS' DEDICATION OF CHILDREN (PARENTAL COMMITMENT)

I (we) have committed our lives to Christ and pledge to raise our child to follow Jesus and to fellowship with a local body of believers (Psalm 149:1; Proverbs 22:6; Hebrews 10:25).

I (we) understand that by dedicating our child at LifePoint, we are acknowledging the church's responsibility to assist us in the process of raising our child by caring for us, praying for us, providing opportunities for corporate worship, fellowship, and teaching, and holding us accountable to provide a positive and biblical upbringing for our child (Deuteronomy 6:6-9; Isaiah 54:13; Ephesians 4:11-16; 5:22-6:4; Acts 2:42-47).

We are married and in full agreement with the Bible's call for one man and one woman to be united in a marriage that is centered on a relationship with God (Genesis 2:24).
